

## **FUNCTIONS OF DISTRICT VOCATIONAL EDUCATION OFFICERS:**

- To promote and popularize Vocational Education programmes in the District.
- To maintain linkage with the Directorate of Intermediate Education, SIVE and Government and Non Governmental Organizations in the District.
- To identify Vocational courses suitable to the local needs.
- To identify locations for Vocational Colleges.
- To facilitate on the job training and apprenticeship training to Vocational Students.
- To supervise Institution – industry linkages.
- To ensure recognition of Vocational Courses and subsequent placement of vocational passouts.
- To review the Vocational courses run in the Colleges and to ensure quality and continued relevance.
- To Coordinate in collecting educational statistical information.
- To function as Convenor of the District Vocational Education Committee.
- To organize the District Vocational Survey and process the data obtained.
- To perform any other work entrusted by the commissioner of Intermediate Education.

### **(c) Institutional level:**

At the institutional level the Govt. of India so far sanctioned 1880 Vocational sections under CSS. Out of these 1680 Vocational section were sanctioned by the State Government so far and sanction is awaited for the remaining 200 sections from the State Government. The following posts were sanctioned by state Government so far at institution level.

Full time Jr Lecturers	: 2025 posts
Part time Jr Lecturers	: 1680 posts
Computer Technicians	: 51 posts
Lab Attenders	: 1680 posts

Out of the above posts only 22 junior lecturers were appointed on regular basis so far. Part time Jr lecturers and lab attender are working against all the remaining posts.

State Govt. issued G.O.Ms.No.302 prescribing the qualifications for the post of vocational Junior Lecturers.

**Examination and Certification:** Board of Intermediate Education will conduct the examination and issue certificates to the passouts.
