The Principals are informed that in view of the representations received from students and parents to permit them to pay the examination fee for Intermediate Public Examinations, March, 2005, the Tatkal Scheme is announced even though the last date for payment of fee was over in October, 2004.

In order to facilitate all such students who did not pay Examination fee, the **TATKAL SCHEME**, will be kept open from **10th December, 2004 to 20th December, 2004.**

Under the Tatkal Scheme the candidates will receive their Hall Tickets from the Colleges where they have submitted the examination application form and DD. They will take their examination at the centre/centres allotted to their college under jumbling system.

A special fee of Rs.1,000/- in addition to the prescribed examination fee is to be paid under this scheme through a Demand Draft drawn in favour of Secretary. Board of Intermediate Education, A.P., Hyderabad payable at Hyderabad. The candidate has to submit an application and previous marks memo along with DD, to the Principal of the College. The Principal has to prepare the Nominal Roll of the candidate/s and submit the same to the RIOs concerned along the DDs and fresh ICR forms on or before **20-12-2004.**

THE FOLLOWING CANDIDATES ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPEAR UNDER TATKAL SCHEME.

- 1 Regular students appearing for the first time and 2nd year regular students.
- 2 Failed students who appeared for Intermediate Public Advanced Supplementary Examinations, June 2004 or before.
- 3 Intermediate Certificate holders who passed Intermediate during March 2003 and afterwards can appear for improvement of their performance.
- 4 Students willing to appear for Intermediate in Arts combination by taking attendance exemption.

PTO

The candidates appeared in IPE earlier to March / June 2002 should submit a fresh ICR form duly affixing the latest **Black and White passport size photograph** (colour photo will be rejected) along with their application and the ICR form should be filled properly and attested by the Principal and the concerned RIO.

In case of 1st / 2nd year Regular candidates the Principal of the Junior College has to certify that the candidate/candidates have put in the required attendance.

Students willing to take attendance exemption and appear under Arts combination should submit a prescribed application form along with exemption fee of Rs.500/- at the Board of Intermediate Education Office. This is in addition to the Tatkal fee and examination fee.

The Principals are requested to give wide publicity to this letter by displaying on the college notice board and also by circulating among the staff and students.
