Sub:- B.I.E., A.P. Vocational Education – Introduction of M.P.H.W (F) courses from the academic year 2008-09 with new syllabus in place of existing M.P.H.W(F) course – Reg.

With reference to the subject cited, it is informed that all the Principals of Junior Colleges who are having Vocational Courses in the state are informed that the existing M.P.H.W(F) course syllabus is revised by adopting the A.N.M. syllabus for the main purpose to recognition of Nursing Council of India and to provide the students with Job oriented skills so as to prepare them for the employment market in the industry and service sector. Therefore it is decided to introduce the above said M.P.H.W (F) course with new syllabus from the Academic Year 2008-09 for 1st year Intermediate Vocational students and from the Academic Year 2009-10 for the 2nd year Intermediate students. There will be three theory papers and three practicals besides on the Job Training uniformly on par with the earlier courses detailed below:

Hence all the Principals are requested to follow the above pattern from the Academic Year 2008-09 for 1st year and from the Academic Year 2009-10 for 2nd year vocational students. The copy of the revised syllabus in M.P.H.W (F) (New) Vocational Course will be sent in due course.

Further, it is also informed that the candidates who have failed in the existing vocational course i.e., M.P.H.W (F) are permitted to appear for failed subjects within two chances in the old syllabus i.e., March 2009 and ASE May/June 2009 for 1st year and March 2010 and ASE May/June 2010 for 2nd year. After these two chances there is no permission to appear for failed subjects in the M.P.H.W (F) with old syllabus.

The above changes may be informed to the students well in advance by giving wide publicity.
