Ref:- This office Press Release, dated: 11-12-2015.

In continuation of the Press Release vide reference cited, I wish to inform that the Intermediate First and Second year Regular and Private eligible candidates who have not paid the Examination fee within the due dates and the candidates seeking Attendance Exemption (Arts only) can pay the Examination fee under **Tatkal Scheme** for Intermediate Public Examinations March 2016.

TATKAL SCHEME Commence from: 12-12-2015 to 18-12-2015.

I. Under the Tatkal Scheme, the candidates will pay the Examination fee in their College and forward their applications from the Colleges where they have studied. They will take their Examination at the Centre allotted by the Board of Intermediate Education. Candidate has to pay the Tatkal examination fee in their respective colleges.

II ATTENDANCE EXEMPTION CANDIATES:

Candidates seeking Attendance Exemption have to pay Rs. **600/-**(Rupees Six hundred only) in addition to the Attendance Exemption fee and Examination fee to the Principal of the college and submit Attendance Exemption form and Examination Application forms to the **Principal of the Government Junior Colleges** as per the above due dates along with original SSC, TC, Intermediate Memo of Marks (for Group Change candidates) and a set of attested Xerox copies of certificates. **The Demand Drafts shall not be accepted from attendance exempted candidates.**

a) Last date for submission of attendance Exemption & Examination application forms by the candidates along **with amount of fee** and enclosures in the college is **18-12-2015.**

b) Las date for submission of I & II Year M. N. Rs of Attendance Exempted candidates along with **online challan** and enclosures by the Principal in R.I.O Offices is **20-12-2015.**

c) Candidates who have a gap of one year after passing the qualifying examination i.e., S.S.C. or its equivalent are eligible to appear only for first year examinations and who have a gap of two years after passing the qualifying examination i.e., S.S.C. or its equivalent examination are eligible to appear for both first and second year examinations as private attendance exemption candidates.

III. Intermediate Pass Certificate holders appearing for Mathematics only as **Additional subject** have to submit the attested copies of Intermediate Pass Certificates in the colleges where they have studied previously.

IV. THE FOLLOWING CANDIDATES ARE ELIGIBLE TO PAY THE EXAMINATION FEE UNDER TATKAL SCHEME.

1. First and Second year Regular eligible candidates who have not paid the Examination fee in time.
2. Intermediate Pass Certificate holders who passed Intermediate in March 2014 & IPASE 2014 and afterwards to appear for **IMPROVEMENT** of their performance.
3. Board of Intermediate Education has dispensed with the condition of 5 (five) years for completion of Intermediate Course. Therefore all the failed candidates of previous examinations are permitted to appear for failed papers only.
4. Candidates willing to appear for Intermediate examinations with change of Group in Arts combination. Intermediate Pass Certificate holders appearing for Mathematics or II Language as additional subjects under Attendance Exemption.
5. Candidates willing to appear privately with Attendance Exemption (for Arts group only).

Improvement of Performance:

Chance of improvement should be availed within two years after passing the Intermediate Public Examinations only. Two chances are allowed for improvement, subject to the condition that such candidates do not prosecute their higher studies during this period. An undertaking has to be given to that effect by the candidate to the Principal of the college concerned.

The attendance exemption and examination application forms can be had from the office of the Regional Inspection Officer, Board of Intermediate Education in the District concerned on payment of Rs. 20/- (Rs.10/- for attendance exemption application form and Rs. 10/- for examination application form).

The above due dates are applicable to both General and Vocational students and also Attendance exempted private candidates for Humanities only (without college study) who wish to appear with change of group for the Intermediate Public Examinations, March 2016.

Incomplete applications and the applications without required enclosures will be rejected.

As such the Principals and the Managements are requested to give wide publicity to the Tatkal scheme fee due dates among the students, parents, and staff of their respective Junior Colleges and also a copy of the same should be displayed on the College Notice Board.
